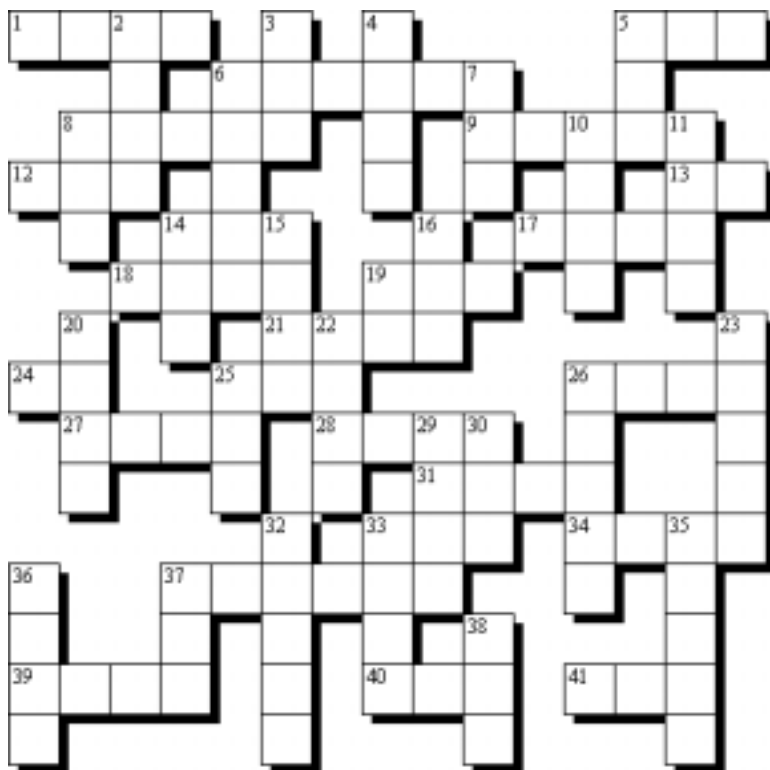


Joseph Puzzle #2
